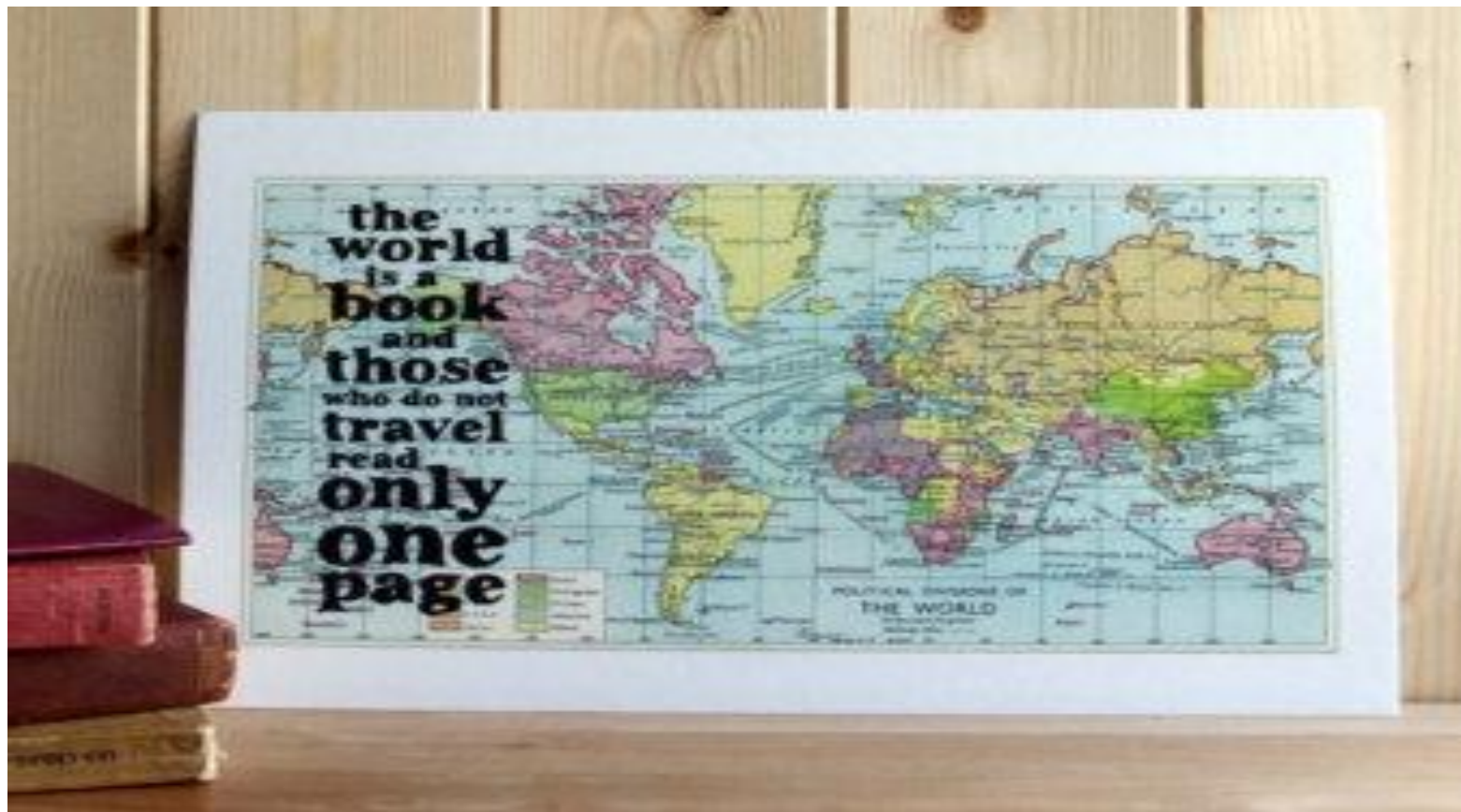

A global dimension is a no brainer for any school leadership





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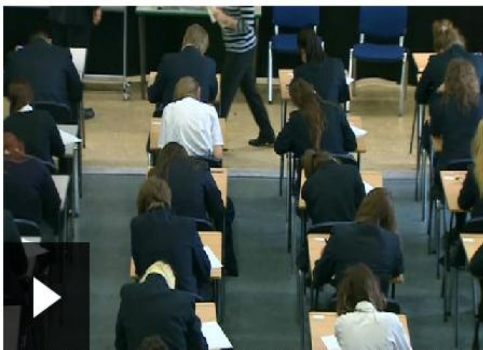
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Pisa ranks Wales' education the worst in the UK

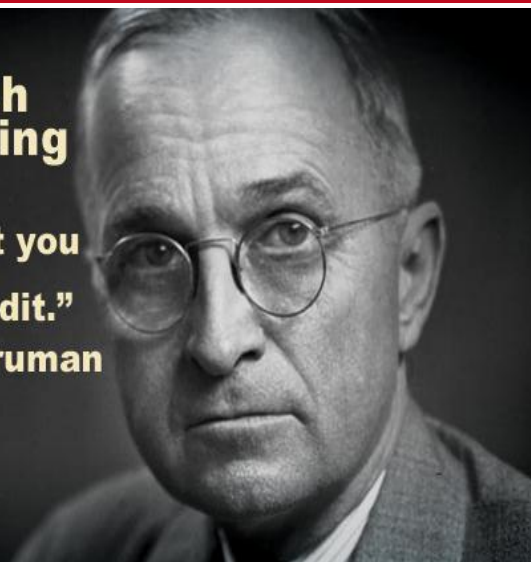

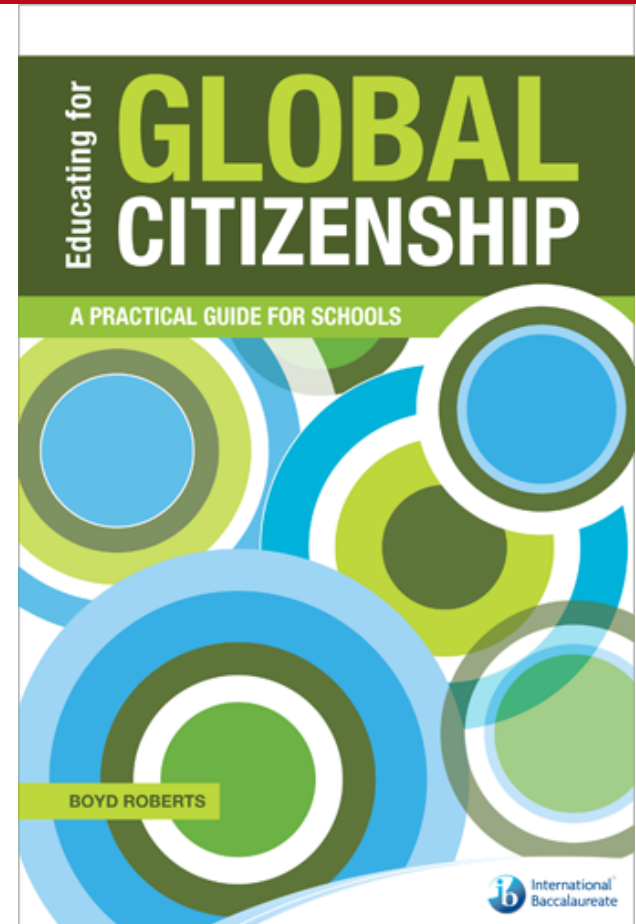


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Global Citizenship needs to focus on the 3 Cs
