3 January Travel grants released

12-16 January Visits take place

Timetable for application

6 February Deadline for submission of full foundation and start-up partnership proposals

16 February Feedback sent to all applicant organisations and grant agreement sent to successful organisations

23 February First installment of grant released

2-6 March Initial video conference for all participating organisations

9 March Partnership projects live

Funding of up to **15000 GBP** is available for each partnership, which must be match-funded by the partnership
