

IT IS NOT YET A NETWORK


- Most institutions work on individual basis
- Good practice is not yet widely disseminated
- Limited chance for inter-institutional collaboration to maximise impacts
- Potential loss of research funding, which look for interdisciplinary and multi-partner approach

 - •Call by July 2016
 - •Concept note by August 2016
 - •Result released by September 2016
- Consortium application is an advantage
