 UoN encourages International collaboration through students and staff exchanges – Pioneered return visits to Vietnam after the Pandemic

Collaboration and operation in Vietnam – our strategic approach

- Recruitment: Attract Vietnamese students to study in the UK
- Transnational Education: Working with our partners to deliver UoN degrees in Vietnam
- Students and staff exchanges: Foster students and staff mobility between the UK and Vietnam
- Joint research: encourage staff engaging in research projects with our Vietnam partners



Student Exchanges at University of Northampton – incoming opportunities for Vietnamese students and staff

- One-term exchange programmes at the UK campus
- Short summer programmes for cultural and academic immersion
- Ad hoc group visits tailored to partner needs
- Academic staff training for lecturers from Vietnam Universities: two weeks to three months



Student Exchanges at University of Northampton – Out going opportunities for UoN students and staff

- Academic visits and flying faculties to partner universities in Vietnam
- Annual two-week study tours to Hanoi and HCM city since 2014
- Joint activities with Vietnamese universities



The impact of Student Exchanges

- Since 2014, over 200 UoN students and 20+ staff have visited Vietnam
- Increased understanding of Vietnamese culture for UK students and staff
- Cross-cultural Collaboration during study tours and joint activities
- Rebuilding relationships post-pandemic : UoN was the first British university to return to Vietnam



The impact of Student Exchanges – Strengthening Academic Partnership

- Joint curriculum development and research opportunities
- Establishing transnational education programmes in Vietnam
- Co-designed programmes that blend UK and Vietnamese educational strengths

- Career opportunities and employability
- Personal growth and independence
- Fostering lifelong connections



Challenges and Opportunities

Challenges:

- Managing logistical and financial constraints for exchanges
- Addressing cultural and language differences

Opportunities:

- Expanding TNE programmes to enhance student mobility
- Leveraging technology to facilitate virtual exchanges



Future directions for British and Vietnamese Universities

- Increase the scale of exchange programmes
- Encourage students and staff to involve and participate
- Develop dual-degree and co-curricular initiatives
- Build a more inclusive network for students with diverse background
